*Abstract*

*The scientific research conducted by the researcher aims to find out how the rights of victims of human trafficking in Indonesia are applied, especially in Batam City based on Law Number 21 of 2007 concerning Eradication of Crime in Trafficking in Person.*

*The research methodology that the researchers used was a type of empirical legal research, as the researchers used the primary data researchers obtained through interviews with the Government, namely in the office of Women's Empowerment, Child Protection, Population, and Family Planning Control in Batam City, Social Services and Community Empowerment in Batam City, and in the Batam City Non-Governmental Organization, namely at the Embun Pelangi Foundation and World Foundation for Women's and secondary data obtained from reference literature.*

*The research results obtained from the interview method and literature study regarding the implementation of the rights of victims of trafficking in persons in the Batam City area can be concluded that the application of the rights of victims of trafficking in person is not fully in accordance with Law Number 21 In 2007 concerning the Eradication of the Crime of Trafficking in Persons as the rights that have not been fulfilled one example is the Right to receive Social Rehabilitation services, the Right to get the services repatriation to the victims city and Right to receive Reintegration services from the Social Service and Community Empowerment of the Batam City Government.*
