

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION, RECOMMENDATIONS, LIMITATIONS

A. Conclusions

1. The conclusion obtained from the discussion above is that the Regional Commission for Observation and Protection of Children (KPPAD) works according to a number of regulations, where the regulation is one of the factors determining the effectiveness of law enforcement. One of the regulation that adopted by Regional Commission for Observation and Protection of Children (KPPAD) has a problem that is conflicting with other regulations, which is 74 Letter b of the Law of Republic of Indonesia Number 35 Year 2014 concerning Child Protection "In case it is needed, the Regional Government can form a Regional Child Protection Commission...." contradicts with the Article 23 Section 2 of Law of Republic of Indonesia Number 35 Year 2014 and Article 32 Letter C of Regional Regulation of Riau Islands Province Number 7 Year 2010.
2. Regional Commission for Observation and Protection of Children (KPPAD) of Riau Islands Province has various duties in accordance with what has been stated in the Regional Law No. 7 of 2010 such as receiving complaints and examining complaints and then conducting socialization to regions to prevent violations of children's rights. But it can be seen from the interviews and data

that the performance of the Observation and Protection of Children (KPPAD) of Riau Islands Province has decreased from year to year for various reasons and has not been able to perform its function effectively according to the Law.

3. Regional Commission for Observation and Protection of Children (KPPAD) of Riau Islands Province experienced many problems that hampered the performance of Regional Commission for Observation and Protection of Children (KPPAD). There are 3 factors of obstacles where these 3 factors also determine the effectiveness of law enforcement namely, facilities, community, and culture. The facilities provided by the local government are inadequate at all. Even though it is the responsibility of the Regional Government in accordance with existing laws to ensure the rights of children are fulfilled. But with inadequate facilities for Regional Commission for Observation and Protection of Children (KPPAD) become an obstacle that hampered their performances. The community still has a habit to be ignorant of other people's problems, there are various reasons for them to be ignorant, some do not want to deal with things that are not related to them, some do not want to deal with complicated matters, and the some are afraid to interfere. And the last one is the culture some people are still often bounded by culture handed down long ago. The culture makes them feel scared of being deemed impolite or disrespectful

because they are involved in taking care of other people's household matters.

B. Recommendations

1. Regional Commission for Observation and Protection of Children (KPPAD) of Riau Islands Province is needed to supervise the implementation of child protection, that is why Regional Commission for Observation and Protection of Children (KPPAD) of Riau Islands Province should improve the performance in order to be able to carry out all the tasks as described in the regulations by increasing the human resources.
2. Regional Government should carry out their obligations to protect children's rights and create child-friendly regions. The Regional Government should also provide the facilities needed by Regional Commission for Observation and Protection of Children (KPPAD) to be able to carry out its tasks and should have quick response towards the problems that faced by Regional Commission for Observation and Protection of Children (KPPAD).
3. The community should not be ignorant of other people's problems and carry out the responsibilities to protect children's rights. Because the protection of children's rights can not be implemented only by depending on the Government.

C. **Limitations**

1. Limitations in finding information through interviews due to time and location limitations, the author can only interview three members of the Regional Commission for Observation and Protection of Children (KPPAD) of Riau Islands Province Commissioner.
