Abstrak

Bums and Beggars are often found in several public facilities in Batam City, their presence is considered to trigger problems such as crime, violence that can be unsettling for people and road users. Here the Social Service and Community Empowerment play a role in managing, controlling the existing problems with the homeless and beggars that have been regulated in Batam City Regulation Number 6 of 2002 concerning Social Order.

Researchers in this case use the empirical juridical research method in which this research is conducted by directly descending the field in order to find out how the forms of supervision carried out by the Social Service and Community Empowerment of the City of Batam in accordance with applicable law. The implementation of social order towards homeless people and beggars has not been effective yet, this is caused by cultural factors which in theory the effectiveness of law has become a culture not a taboo if a beggar and homeless people are given a number of funds or donations by the community, so they become lazy to be able to work much better, because by being homeless and beggars are able to make a lot of money without having to work hard.

So the researchers hope that the government can revise Batam City Regulation No. 6 of 2002 concerning Social Order in the form of applying sanctions to the community as donors aimed at reducing the number of homeless and beggars in Batam City.
