ABSTRACT

This research was made to find out and describe cyber-bullying on social media if it is categorized according to sources in Islamic law, discussion of cyber-bullying is related to the implementation of Islamic law in Indonesia, and efforts to provide legal protection for perpetrators and victims of cyber-bullying in Islamic law or national law in Indonesia. Based on the facts found in the community, cyber-bullying is a new crime arising because of the irresponsible or unwise behavior of certain parties in the use of technology and information media. Cyber-bullying is defined as a crime committed to disturbing the victim by the use and utilization of electronic media (Willard, 2005).

The preparation of this research was conducted using normative juridical legal research so that the data obtained was the result of literature review in the form of secondary, primary and tertiary legal materials containing laws, journals, and books correlated with the title research determined. The case approach in this study was also used to examine how the application of legal norms or rules is carried out in legal practice.

Based on this research, the results obtained related to cyber-bullying on social media in the perspective of Islamic law is categorized as Jarimah Ta'zir so that it can be subject to Uqubat ta'zir, the amount of which is determined by the ruler or judge. Legal protection related to these actions has been regulated based on Islamic law as well as national law in force in Indonesia.
