The purpose of practical work that is done is to facilitate the public in understanding the legal services outside the court building in accordance with SEMA Number 10 of 2010 concerning Guidelines for Providing Legal Aid that has been updated with the Supreme Court Regulation No. 1 of 2014 concerning Guidelines for Providing Legal Services to the Community Incapable of Courts. So far, information about the existence of court services outside the court building is still very minimal, so that the wider community has not known much about it, even though this service has been provided by the Batam Class-1A Religious Court since 2010.

In the implementation of practical work, the method used is empirical legal research or commonly called sociological legal research or field research, by dividing it into three stages, namely the preparation stage, namely the stage in observing and identifying the problems found, the implementation stage, namely the stage of collecting data, find solutions and design projects, and the assessment and reporting stages.
