Abstract

The implementation of this research was to find out whether legal protection for victims of pedophile crime in the city of Batam was in accordance with Law No. 35 of 2014 concerning Amendments to Law Number 23 of 2002 concerning Child Protection.

This research was conducted by researchers using the normative juridical research method. This research is the main approach, namely revealing normative rules and legal principles which are policies in formulating criminal acts of pedophile. The method used in this study was qualitative analysis method, namely by explaining and explaining the data in the form of sentences arranged with the subject, objectives and concepts related to it systematically, then carried out discussion and analysis of the conclusions in response to the subject matter presented in the research.

Based on the results of this study, it can be concluded that there is a difference between the rights that children should get according to Law Number 35 of 2014 concerning Amendments to Law Number 23 of 2002 concerning Child Protection with existing facts or in the real life. As well as the Commission for the Supervision and Protection of Regional Children of Riau Islands Province, which is an institution that should also protect the rights of these children, it has not been maximal in its efforts.
