ANALYSIS OF RIGHTS FULFILLMENT FOR CONVICTED WITH EXCEEDING CAPACITY CONDITIONS (CASE STUDY IN THE INSTITUTION OF WOMEN CLASS IIB BATAM)

ABSTRACT

This research is based on the overcapacity condition experienced by almost all correctional institutions in Indonesia, one of which is the Class IIB Women's Prison in Batam which exceeds capacity up to 169% based on 2019 data. Departing from these problems, this study was made with the intent to find out how the rights fulfillment for prisoners' rights exceeding the capacity in the Class IIB Women's Prison in Batam, as well as knowing what obstacles faced in fulfilling these prisoners' rights.

This research used empirical juridical research approached by looking directly at the situation in the field to collect a variety of primary data. The method used is to conduct interviews with prison officers and observations in the Batam Class IIB Women's Lapas Batam and the legal instrument used to analyze this topic was the theory of legal effectiveness from Soerjono Soekanto.

Based on the data obtained in this study, the results show the fulfillment of prisoners' rights with exceeding capacity conditions are not yet fully functioning. Rights that have not been fully obtained by these prisoners due to various factors and constraints are infrastructure facilities inadequate and inadequate human resources.
